## Election

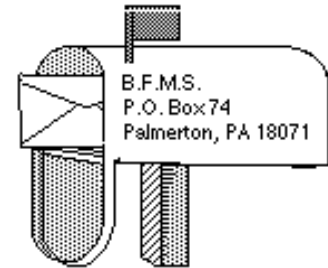
Please attend the next meeting (January 11, 2014) to help elect the nominees who will help lead the club during the next year in the position of President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.
