

**PLANE LIST** – I have the manuals for all except the BD-5 and the parasail.

**<u>1-HABU 1<sup>st</sup> Gen</u>** – Park Zone: Experienced beginner and up

2-BD5 - ?? Experienced flyer

3- SPITFIRE w/ OS.25cu in nitro – Great Planes: Intermediate flyer with low wing experience

<u>4- P51 Mustang</u> – Hangar 9 (This is the plane I first flew at the BFMS field after over 20yrs away from the hobby.) Experienced beginner with an instructor transitioning to low wing models.

5- ElectroStreak - Great Planes: set up for 7.4V LiPo (I think. LOL)

<u>6- Fly Swallow - 46</u> – Manufacture not listed on the manual. Underpowered with stock motor.

7- ParaSail – Can't find the transmitter. May be able to convert to 3-2 channel Futaba or another Rx. Fun to fly.

**<u>8- Ultimate</u>** – Seagull. Cartwheeled and damaged wings/rudder. Brand new wings in boxes. Need to make a solid rudder.

Easy to repair. (or may find a replacement on the Internet.) Flew good.

<u>9- F15 Eagle ducted fan</u> – E-flite for intermediate and above fliers

10- A-10 Warthog - Not sure what Rx is in it.
